INSTRUCTIONAL RESOURCES

INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS SELECTION AND ADOPTION

Textbooks and instructional materials, both print and non-print, are selected based on quality and educational value, and must contribute to a general sense of the worth of all individuals regardless of sex, race, religion, nationality, ethnic origin, disability, or any other differences which may exist.

Textbooks and instructional materials shall be adopted consistent with provisions of The School Code of Illinois.

The Superintendent shall recommend to the Board for consideration and adoption all textbooks and instructional materials based upon the recommendations of the curriculum committees. The Superintendent's recommendation to the Board shall include the following information:

- recommended texts, including the title, publisher, copyright dates, number of copies desired and cost;
- texts being replaced, publisher and copyright dates;
- rationale for recommendation; and
- selection method.
