COMMUNITY RELATIONS

PARENTAL INVOLVEMENT

In order to assure collaborative relationships between students' families and the School Board and District personnel, and to enable parent(s)/guardian(s) to become active partners in education, the Superintendent shall develop and implement administrative procedures to:

- 1. Keep parent(s)/guardian(s) thoroughly informed about their child's school and education.
- 2. Encourage involvement in their child's school and education.
- 3. Establish effective two-way communication between all families and the School Board and District personnel.
- 4. Seek the advice of parent(s)/guardian(s) on school governance issues and methods to fulfill the District's educational mission.
- 5. Inform parent(s)/guardian(s) on how they can assist their children's learning.

The Superintendent shall periodically report to the School Board on the implementation of this policy.
